## Notice of Decision to Acquire Treasury Stock

(Treasury Stock Acquisition under the Articles of Incorporation Pursuant to Article 459, Paragraph 1 of the Companies Act)

TSUGAMI CORPORATION (the "Company") announced today the completion on December 9, 2016 of acquisition of treasury stock resolved at a meeting of the Board of Directors held on August 10, 2016.

The Company resolved to acquire treasury stock under Article 459, Paragraph 1 of the Companies Act at a meeting of the Board of Directors held today. Details are as follows:

1. Reason for the acquisition of treasury stock

The Company will acquire treasury stock to execute flexible capital policies in response to changes in the business environment.

2. Matters related to the acquisition of treasury stock

(1) Type of stock to be acquired: Common stock of the Company

(2) Number of shares that can be acquired: 2,000 thousand shares (maximum)

(3.24% of the number of shares outstanding (excluding treasury stock))

(3) Total acquisition cost: 1,300 million yen (maximum)

(4) Acquisition period: From December 12, 2016 to June 20, 2017
